LETTER FROM THE CEO



Over the last half century, Delta Dental of Tennessee has remained committed to the advancement of the overall health of Tennesseans through providing dental benefits, educational programs, and philanthropic efforts.

Delta Dental of Tennessee was first formed as Tennessee Dental Services Corporation in 1965 as the result of enabling legislation passed by the Tennessee General Assembly. The name was officially changed to Delta Dental of Tennessee in 1970.

Since then, Delta Dental of Tennessee has grown to become the largest independent dental insurance provider in the state, with more than 2,000 employer groups protecting over 1.2 million members.

Since 2003, Delta Dental has given more than \$18.5 million to our community through more than 100 dental clinics, dental schools, charities, hospitals, and other organizations across Tennessee.


